2011 South Dakota Quilters Guild Fall Retreat and Quilt Show

The Quilt Show will be held on September 24-25 at the Crossroads Convention Center in Huron. The theme is Kaleidoscope of Color.

All types of quilts, quilted garments, table runners, items by youth (under 18), anything quilted you want to enter will be accepted. There will be a category to enter it in.

Don't forget your challenge pieces. Margene still has a few packages of the challenge fabric left. The challenge pieces will be judged by the public.

The registration form for your quilts and other items is in the newsletter. Please read the instructions and print out as many as you need. Each entry must have 3 forms. One to send in along with your registration fee to Patti, 2nd one is to hang on the quilt and the 3rd is what you will need to claim your quilt on Sunday afternoon. If you have any questions contact Patti or Mary, their information is on the registration form.

Please submit your entrees by the due date. We need to let the rental place know on September 16th how many poles we will need for the show.

The rental place will be delivering the poles on Thursday so the setup for them will be on Thursday night 5pm. Friday we need all the quilts in Huron between 9am to 3pm so the volunteers can get them hung up. Friday night after the evening meal will be a class offered by Bev Mader. Vendors will be open on Friday night, Saturday and Sunday for our shopping pleasure. Saturday will be the show which includes free demos and some take and go projects. Raffle tickets for our beautiful quilt will be sold and the drawing will be held on Sunday. Lunch and business meeting at noon. Nancy and Roxan will be doing a Lecture/Mini Trunk Show (this is an additional cost if you wish to attend) at 2pm. After our Saturday evening meal we are going to be entertained by Yvonne Hollenbeck of Clearfield, SD at the trunk show for our September meeting. In addition to her presentations of cowboy poetry, Yvonne's program entitled "Patchwork of the Prairie" is one of the finest presentations in the heartland. Yvonne shows her collection of family quilts, spanning 140 years, including her own prize-winning creations. Poetry about quilts and quilters is presented throughout this awesome trunk show, which is enjoyed by men and women alike.

Spiral Table Runner Class

Bev Mader from Always Your Design will teach the Spicy Spiral Table Runner on Friday evening. Come join us for this class, learn the technique to make this runner. It's fast, fun and beautiful! You will finish this runner in class. Ruler, patterns, and kits will be available. You do not have to buy a kit, you can put together your own fabrics. A supply list will be furnished upon registration.

If you want to do this class we do need to know in advance so Bev has enough supplies along. Kits are available in several different fabric from Always Your Design for \$37.95 and the ruler is \$28.95. Call them in advance so they have enough kits and rulers to bring along. Kits that they have done up are: Pastel-Green to Pink, Kansas Trouble-Burgundy to Gold, Batik-Blue to Green, Dragon Fly Fabric-Black to Brown, Batik-Dark Purple to Light Purple and Batik-Burgundy to Turquoise. Please mark yourself down for the class on the registration form.

September 2011 Block Exchange

Everyone is welcome to join in on the fun of making a block for the "Block Exchange". All you have to do is make a quilt block and turn it in at the next SDQG meeting and put your name in the drawing to have a chance to win the blocks. Thanks to Nancy Hein for turning in our current block.

Checked Friendship Block

Block Size 12 1/2 inch unfinished

Two different fabrics and your color choice

Checked Print:

Cut 2 2 7/8 inch squares

Cut 4 3 1/4 inch squares

Cut 1 2 7/8 inch by 7 3/4 inch rectangle

Dark Coordinate:

Cut 12 2 7/8 inch squares

Cut 4 3 1/4 inch square

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on wrong side of 4 checked 3 1/4 inch squares. Place on 3 1/4 inch dark squares, right sides together. Stitch 1/4 inch on both sides of diagonal line. Cut on solid center line. Press towards the dark.
2. Assemble two rows as shown.
3. Assemble 2 different rows as shown.
4. Sew one dark 2 7/8 inch square on each end of the 2 7/8 inch by 7 1/4 inch strip.
5. Assemble block as shown.

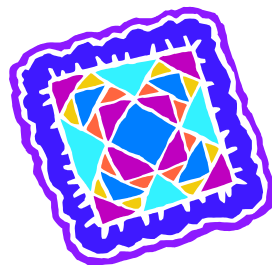
